CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ROBERT NIGHTENGALE

of Prineville, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Crooked River

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of irrigation of 404.0 acres, stock and domestic use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 449; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for stock and domestic use, and 5.05 cubic feet per second from July 1 to September 15 of each year for irrigation

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 1, T16S, R15E, WM; Biggs, Rice and Baldwin Ditch - 280 feet South and 120 feet West from S 1/4 Corner, Section 36, T15S, R15E, WM.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 650, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and is issued to confirm changes in points of diversion and places of use approved by order of the State Engineer entered February 3, 1943 and August 24, 1953, and supersedes Certificate 650.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
