## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** *That* SHIRLEY N. LEE

of PO Box 35, Mt. Vernon, State of Oregon 97865, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of John Day River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 81.0 acres

under Permit No. E-134 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 1, 1912

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.01 cubic feet per second if available at the original point of diversion, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 25, T13S, R30E, WM; South 72 degrees East, 2705 feet from NW Corner, Section 25

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 25, T13S, R30E, WM (Panama Ditch); 390 feet South and 2100 feet East from NW Corner, Section 25; SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 24, T13S, R29E, WM (Pump); 930 feet North and 2200 feet East from SW Corner, Section 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in points of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 20, 1978 and together with Certificate 52024 , supersedes Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 1684, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.*
