CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, *That* SHIRLEY N. LEE

of P.O. Box 35, Mt. Vernon, State of Oregon 97865, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of John Day River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 8.5 acres and supplemental irrigation of 13.8 acres

under Permit No. 41442 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 12, 1976

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.56 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 24, T13S, R29E, WM; PUMP - 930 feet North and 2200 feet East from SW Corner Section 24, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 25, T13S, R30E, WM; PANAMA DITCH - 390 feet South and 2100 feet East from the NW Corner Section 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre SW 1/4 SE 1/4
Supplemental
13.8 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 24
Township 13 South, Range 29 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
