CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. M. GARNER

of Kerby, State of Oregon 97531, has a right to the use of the waters of Sucker Creek

a tributary of East Fork Illinois River for the purpose of irrigation of 10.0 acres and domestic for Tract 1; irrigation of 7.5 acres for Tract 2

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1 and 5 at page s * ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902 for Tract 1; 1908 for Tract 2,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second for Tract 1; 0.09 cfs for Tract 2, and that use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1 to October 31 of each year;

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 7130, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources Director entered on November 18, 1983, approving Transfer Application 5294.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
