CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That CARLON CATTLE COMPANY

of Box 25, Summer Lake, State of Oregon 97640, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Silver Lake for the purpose of irrigation of 153.8 acres

under Permit No. G-6891 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 12, 1976 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.92 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 24, T28S, R15E, WM; 630 feet North and 30 feet East from W 1/4 Corner Section 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.3 acre NE 1/4 NE 1/4
- 1.2 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
- Section 23
- 1.0 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4
- 2.3 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4
- 32.7 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4
- 31.5 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4
- 37.7 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4
- 38.1 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4
- 4.7 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4
- 4.3 acres Lot 4 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4)
- Section 24
- Township 28 South, Range 15 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
