## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said nurvoses, and fittill not exceed not be a sere foot per acre don't be any 30-day period after June 1st, of each year; and two and one-half acre feet per acre during any irrigation season; to be diverted under a head of not to exceed one-fortieth of a second foot per acre.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurlenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Ten (10) acres in the  $N_2^2$   $N_2^2$   $NV_2^2$   $NV_2^2$ , Section 12, Township 40 South Range 19 East of the Willamette Moridian.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lunds or place of use herein described.
