CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN D. McRAE

of Burns, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Malheur River

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of irrigation of 16.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 228; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from September 1887

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 1/2 acre-feet per acre in any 30-day period prior to June 1, 1 acre-foot per acre in any 30-day period after June 1 of each year or 3 acre-feet per acre during any season, diverted at a rate not to exceed 1/20 of a cubic foot per second per acre.

The point of diversion is located in the Fairman Blaylock Ditch;

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 51210, Volume 45, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 3, 1983 approving Transfer Application 5309.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
