CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FEDERAL LAND BANK

of Spokane, State of Washington, has
a right to the use of the waters of John Day River and Johnson Creek

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of
irrigation of 49.1 acres and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1905

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed * See Below

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 33, T8S, R25E, WM for
River and NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 33, T8S, R25E, WM for Creek.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

* John Day River - one-fortieth cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to 1.0 acre-foot per acre per calendar month; total of 5.0 acre-feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

Johnson Creek - one-fortieth cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and one-eightieth cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to 1.0 acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and 4.0 acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30, measured at point of diversion.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 35285, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on November 18, 1983, approving Transfer Application 5258, and not canceled by order of the Water Resources Director dated November 18, 1983.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
