CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That RAFTER Q CATTLE COMPANY

Lower Crooked River Road of Rt 1, Box 113, Redmond, State of Oregon 97756, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Crooked River

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of irrigation of 93.0 acres

under Permit No. 9561 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 17, 1930

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

1.17 cubic feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 22, T14S, R15E, WM; 1110 feet North from SW Corner, Section 22

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 24, T14S, R15E, WM; 2930 feet South and 4620 feet East from NW Corner, Section 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 31.5 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4
- 15.0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
- 9.4 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
- 37.1 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4

Section 24
Township 14 South, Range 14 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 23, 1978 and supersedes Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 10868, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
