CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE

of PO Box 3503, Portland, State of Oregon 97208, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of maintenance of Canyon Creek Meadows Reservoir constructed under Permit R-2872, and fish propagation under Permit No. 28010 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 21, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 29, T15S, R33E, WM; 1110 feet North and 2010 feet West from SE Corner, Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to -----of one cubic foot per second per acre,-----the period when the flow of the John Day River is more than 30 cubic feet per second at USGS Gage No. 14-0465 and more than 20 cfs at USGS Gage No. 14-0480,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

W 1/2 SW 1/4
Section 28
SE 1/4
Section 29
Township 15 South, Range 33 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
