CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, *That* GEO. O. and CORA E. HARSHMAN

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has
a right to the use of the waters of Walla Walla River

a tributary of for the purpose of
irrigation of 2.02 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1875

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as

Section 2
Township 5 North, Range 35 East, WM

Being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 53 rods south of the center of Section 2, Township 5 North, Range 35 East, WM, running thence north 5 rods; thence east 13 1/3 rods; thence south 20 feet; thence west 12 rods 2 feet; thence south 4 rods 13 feet; thence west 20 feet; thence south 20 2/3 rods; thence west 20 rods; thence along the base of a hill in a northwesterly direction 18 rods 6 feet; thence north 21 2/3 rods to a point 38 rods 3 feet south of the east and west line passing through the center of Section 2 aforesaid; thence in a southeasterly direction 36 rods to the place of beginning, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 12973, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 24, 1984, approving Transfer Application 5471.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
