CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Route 1, Mosier , State of Oregon 97040 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Mosier Creek

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 1.7 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 15841 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

June 28, 1944 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.028 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot $\,4\,$ (NW $\,1/4\,$ SW $\,1/4$) and Lot $\,5\,$ (SW $\,1/4\,$ SW $\,1/4$), Section 19, T2N, R12E, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sixtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from March 1 to October 1

and shal

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.7 acres Lot 5 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4)
Section 19
Township 2 North, Range 12 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 19577, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 2, 1984.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
