and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oreyon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 77 , at page 233 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1889 for tract No. 1, 1890 for tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three-fourths acre foot per acre during any 30-day period prior to June 1st, and one-half acre foot per acre during any 30-day period prior to June 1st, and one-half acre foot per acre during any 30-day period after June 1st, of each year; and two and one-half acre feet per acre during any Irrigation season; to be diverted under a head of not to exceed one-fortieth of a second foot per acre.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appartenant

(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1: 0.9 acres in the SDISE, Section 19, 22.7 acres in the NELWEL, 39.5 acres in the SEAREL, Section 30, 2.0 acres in the SWANWA, Section 29, Township 37 South Range 20 East of the Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 2: 10.5 acres in the NELTHER, 23 acres in the SEINE, Section 29, Township 37 South Range 20 East of the Willamette Meridian.

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And said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place

of use herein described.
