CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That REDLANDS DITCH AND IRRIGATION COMPANY

of Kerby, State of Oregon 97531, has a right to the use of the waters of Sucker Creek

a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of irrigation of 101.0 acres and domestic for Tract 1; irrigation of 18.8 acres for Tract 2

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume S 1\*, at pages 253\*\* that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893 for Tract 1 and 1908 for Tract 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.02 cubic feet per second for Tract 1, 0.24 cubic foot per second for Tract 2, and that the use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1 to October 31 of each year;

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 32, Township 39 South, Range 7 West, WM.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
