CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

BAKER VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT

of PO Box 127, Baker , State of Oregon 97814 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Powder River and Phillips Lake

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of irrigation of 48.1 acres and supplemental irrigation of 140.7 acres

under Permit No. 35727 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 18, 1971 for Powder River; September 15, 1971 for Phillips Lake that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.3 cubic feet of water per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 25, TlOS, R38E, WM – Phillips Lake (Mason Dam: 50 feet South and 1,500 feet West from NE Corner Section 25); see final proof map for others

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-5083, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to the use of stored water only on lands described as supplemental (storage only)

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
