CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That CROCKER FARMS

of Route 1, Box 617, Monroe, State of Oregon 97456, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Marys River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 63.2 acres

under Permit No. 39279 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 8, 1974 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.79 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Brown DLC 54, Section 20, T12S, R5W, WM; 30 feet North and 1220 feet West from SE Corner Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 8.0 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Brown DLC 54
- 4.4 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Brown DLC 54
- 0.1 acre SE 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Brown DLC 54
- Section 17
- 7.6 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Brown DLC 54
- 29.6 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Brown DLC 54
- 13.5 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Brown DLC 54
- Section 20
- Township 12 South, Range 5 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
