CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That MARY L. COOKMAN

of 11401 Upper Cow Creek Road, Azalea, State of Oregon 97410, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.9 acres

under Permit No. 37222 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 22, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 2, T32S, R4W, WM; 390 feet South and 785 feet West from NE 1/16 Corner, Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-seventieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.9 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 2
Township 32 South, Range 4 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
