that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second, being 0.10 cfs for domestic and 0.05 cfs for commercial

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
