that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.013 cfs from unnamed spring branch and 0.007 cfs from spring if available at the original point of diversion on unnamed spring branch

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 11, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 2, T26S, R3W, WM; Unnamed spring branch - 550 feet South and 1050 feet West; Spring - 170 feet North and 1100 feet West, both from N 1/4 Corner, Section 11.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 23409, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on September 5, 1978, approving transfer application 3926 and is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by the same order and supersedes certificate 23409.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
