CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That LEO F. WYNDEARO

of 2837 Beall Lane, Central Point, State of Oregon 97501, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.4 acre and domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 41154 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 8, 1976 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.010 cfs for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 17, T26S, R3W, WM; 440 feet South and 50 feet East from SW Corner DLC 41.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic and 0.4 acre Lot 2 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) Section 17 Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM

This certificate is issued so as to correctly describe the location of the diversion point and the place of use and supersedes Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 48796, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
