CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CITY OF CANYONVILLE

of City Hall, PO Box 765, Canyonville, , State of Oregon 97417 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of municipal use

under Permit No. 15683 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 28, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.022 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within James G. Clark DLC 51, Section 27, T30S, R5W, WM. and further limited to use only during the irrigation season and *

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within J. Reynolds DLC 58, Section 34, T30S, R5W, WM; 1754 feet South and 1197 feet East from SE Corner, J. Roberts DLC 59.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 4, 1979 and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 48939, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 15621

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
