that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 27, T3OS, R5W, WM; 460.3 feet South and 516.3 feet West from SE Corner, James G. Clark DLC 51

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within J. Reynolds DLC 58, Section 34, T3OS, R5W, WM; 1754 feet South and 1197 feet East from SE Corner, J. Roberts DLC 59.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to—————— of one cubic foot per second per acre,
