CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That JEAN V. BERRY

of Box 457, Canyonville, State of Oregon 97417, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.4 acre

under Permit No. 1077 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

February 10, 1912 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.005 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 27, T30S, R5W, WM; 14 rods South and 20 rods West from the NE Corner, J. Robert DLC 59 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 27, T30S, R5W, WM; 200 feet South and 1280 feet West from N 1/4 Corner, Section 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighthieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 0.4 acre NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 27 Township 30 South, Range 5 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 27, 1979 and together with certificates of water right recorded at pages 52544, 52545 and 52547, Volume 47, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 48132.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
