CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FREDERICK K. ROBERTSON

of Route 1, Box 981, Dayville, State of Oregon 97825, has a right to the use of the waters of John Day River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 15.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from March 14, 1906

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to 1 acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; total 5 acre-feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion

The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 12, T13S, R27E, WM; NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 18, T13S, R28E, WM; 1,386 feet North and 1,518 feet West, 560 feet South and 1,250 feet East both from SE Corner, Section 12, T13S, R27E, WM

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.0 acres Lot 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) Section 18 Township 13 South, Range 28 East, WM

This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded at page 51186, Volume 45, State Record of Water Right Certificates which should have superseded Certificate 25851.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
