CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That N. HAZEL ENYART

of Trail, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 7.58 acres and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.152 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 32, T33S, R1E, WM; Enyart Ditch - 3,009 feet South and 2,431 feet West from NE Corner, Section 32.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.43 acre SE 1/4 NW 1/4
7.15 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 32
Township 33 South, Range 1 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 15828, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 16, 1984, approving Transfer Application 5490, and orders entered in Volume 5, pages 228 and 543 and in Volume 13, pages 185 and 206.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
