CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, *That* RICK HARVEY

of Route 1, Box 69, Tygh Valley, State of Oregon 97063, has
a right to the use of the waters of Tygh Creek

a tributary of White River for the purpose of
irrigation of 192.5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 7, at page 196; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1877 for Tract 1 and 1866 for Tract 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre-feet per acre during irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in paragraph 24 of said decree); if available at the original point of diversion; NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 3, T4S, R13E, WM; 910 feet South and 1010 feet West from Center of Section 3 (Bonney Ditch).
The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 11, T4S, R13E, WM; 20 feet South and 1940 feet East from the NW Corner, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 11.
