## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That F. W. PAYNE

has a right to the use of

the waters of

Thomas Creek:

for the purpose of Irrigation of 103.4 acres and stock use:

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Leke County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 233; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from February 17, 1879;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed. Three-fourths acre foot per acre curing any 30-day period prior to June 1st, and one-half acre foot per acre any 30-day period after June 1st, of each year; and two and one-half acre feet per acre during any irrigation season; to be diverted under a head of not to exceed one-fortieth of a second foot per acre.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurlenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40 acres in NE NV 13.9 acres in NW NV 29.5 acres in SW NV 14.40 acres in SE NV 25.5 acres in SE NV 25.5 acres in NV 25.5

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
