CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That FLOYD AND VENITA BRANCH

of Fort Rock, State of Oregon 97735, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Fort Rock Basin for the purpose of irrigation of 134.7 acres

under Permit No. G-8678 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 15, 1979 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.68 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the Lot 6, Section 3, T26S, R14E, WM; 3060 feet South and 1380 feet East from NW Corner, Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 34.7 acres Lot 6
- 32.7 acres Lot 5
- 33.7 acres Lot 12
- 33.6 acres Lot 11
- Section 3
- Township 26 South, Range 14 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
