of PO Box 428, Roseburg , State of Oregon 97470 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 15.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 46654 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 3, 1981

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.1875 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 Section 15, T2BS, R6W, WM; 1490 feet North and 2460 feet East from SW Corner Section 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second acre. or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre—feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 10.0 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 15 Township 28 South, Range 6 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein. described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
