CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CHARLES M. PETERSON

of Route 1, Box 164, Halfway, State of Oregon 97834, has
a right to the use of the waters of Clear Creek

a tributary of Pine Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 29.0 acres and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 11, at page 235; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1891 for Tract 2 and 1910 for Tract 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of a
cubic foot per second per acre, measured at the point of diversion, and a
total limitation of one acre-foot per acre during July, one acre-foot per acre
during August, and one-half acre-foot per acre during September, of each year,
if available at the original point of diversion; NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 5, *
The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 32, T7S, R46E, WM; 920
feet North and 950 feet East from SW Corner, Section 32.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

- * T8S, R46E, WM; Morrison Private Ditch - 1750 feet North and 530 feet West
from Center 1/4 Corner, Section 5.

TRACT 2
18.0 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4

TRACT 3
11.0 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 5
Township 8 South, Range 46 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved
by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 22, 1978 and
together with certificate of water right recorded at page 47252, Volume 40,
State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes Certificate 10412.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to
forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
