CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That GARY F. SWANSON

of 2174 Del Rio Road, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.9 acre and stock

under Permit No. 42676 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 2, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cfs for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within McKinney DLC 45, Section 23, T26S, R6W, WM; 50 feet South and 1950 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Stock and 0.8 acre SE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within McKinney DLC 45 Section 14

0.1 acre NE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within McKinney DLC 45 Section 23 Township 26 South, Range 6 West, WM

The place of use is more explicitly described as Lot 1, Del Rio Ranch Estates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
