CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That JOHN C. KENNEDY

of PO Box 128, Idleyld Park, State of Oregon 97447, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and two commercial buildings

under Permit No. 36143 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 20, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.016 cubic foot per second, being 0.003 cfs for domestic use and 0.013 cfs for commercial buildings

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 11, T26S, R3W, WM; South 39 degrees 30 minutes East 1005 feet from the NW Corner, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 7 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4)
Section 11
Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 41298, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on November 2, 1984, approving Transfer Application 5520.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
