of Star Route, Box 488, Winston State of Oregon 97496 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpgua River

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 7.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 5496 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 24, 1922

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second, if a wailable at the original point of diversion,

0.09 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 22, T28S, R6W, WM; 2112 feet North and 1584 feet West from SE Corner, Section 22.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the \$\$ \text{W1/4}\$, \$\text{Sction 22}\$, \$\text{T285}\$, \$\text{R6M}\$, \$\text{WM}\$, \$\text{45}\$ feet North and \$1280\$ feet East from Center 1/4 Corner, Section 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre.

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.0 acres SN 1/4 NE 1/4

Section 22 Township 28 South, Range 6 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 27, 1978, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 46173, Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes Certificate 7481.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
