CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That ROSEBURG LUMBER COMPANY

of PO Box 1088, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River and log pond constructed under Permit R-822

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of wood products manufacturing including log storage at Plywood Plant 3

under Permit No. 24062 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 8, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.2 cubic foot per second, if available at the original points of diversion, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 29, T28S, R6W, WM; 1 - 670 feet North and 990 feet East from S 1/4 Corner, Section 29; 2 - 986 feet South and 175 * or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 2, T28S, R6W, WM; 3600 feet North and 2800 feet East from SW Corner, Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * feet East from C 1/4 Corner, Section 29
- S 1/2 NE 1/4
- NE 1/4 SW 1/4
- N 1/2 SE 1/4
- Section 2
- Township 28 South, Range 6 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 27, 1978 and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 48440, Volume 41, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate 23333.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
