CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MAUD KUBLI

of Applegate, State of Oregon 97530, has
a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 82.2 acres, domestic use and stock use in Tract 1 and mining in
Tract 2

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1866 for Tract 1 and 1858 for Tract 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.07 cubic feet
per second for Tract 1 and 9.50 cfs for Tract 2.

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 30, T38S, R3W, WM; 2510
feet South and 3370 feet West from the NE Corner of the George Long DLC 39 for
Tract 1 and SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 29, T38S, R3W, WM; 1950 feet South and 1800
feet West from the NE Corner of Section 29 for Tract 2.
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
