CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That JERRY WAYNE JENSON

of 400 Mona Way, Cave Junction, State of Oregon 97523, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Tycer Creek and Perdin Creek

a tributary of Kelley Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 0.3 acre

under Permit No. 38877 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 30, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cfs from Tycer Creek and 0.01 cfs from Perdin Creek when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Perdin Creek to be made up by appropriation from Tycer Creek provided that the* or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 19, T39S, R7W, WM; Diversion 1 - 580 feet South and 760 feet East; Diversion 2 - 650 feet South and 1210 feet East, both from N 1/4 Corner, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.01 cfs

TYCER CREEK
0.2 acre NW 1/4 NE 1/4

PERDIN CREEK
with deficiencies from Tycer Creek
0.1 acre NW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 19
Township 39 South, Range 7 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
