CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, ThatBOISE CASCADE CORPORATION
CHEMICAL OPERATIONS DIVISION

of PG Box 851, Stanfield, State of OR 97875, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Stanfield Drain

a tributary of Umatilla River for the purpose of
irrigation of 5.8 acres

under Permit No. 18122 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
November 18, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is
limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.08 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion
in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 31, T4N, R29E, WM; 1550 feet North and 15 feet West
from the SE Corner, Section 31
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of
diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 31, T4N, R29E, WM;
1770 feet North and 1230 feet West from SE Corner, Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right
existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per
acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further
limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each
acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

5.8 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 31
Township 4 North, Range 29 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use, and point of
diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July
27, 1978, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page
46830, Volume 39, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes
Certificate 26099.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to
forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date
prior to this right.
