that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 18, T5N, R36E, WM; 410 feet North and 63 feet East from SW Corner NW 1/4, Section 18 (Milton Ditch).

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.21 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 3 Township 5 North, Range 35 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 9, 1980 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on page 12963, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
