and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.115 cubic foot per second and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed three acre-feet per acre in any irrigation season.

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 31, T1N, R14E, WM; Bauer Ditch - 1420 feet North and 100 feet West from SW Corner, Section 32.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.2 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 32 Township 1 North, Range 14 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 5600, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NDT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 21, 1982, approving Transfer Application 5012.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
