CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, *That* ROGER JONES

of Route 1, Box 655, Ontario, State of Oregon 97914, has
a right to the use of the waters of Willow Creek, stored in Reservoir 3, and Black
Creek and Pole Creek, stored in Reservoir 1 of Orchards Water Company, also
the direct flow thereof
a tributary of Malheur River for the purpose of
irrigation of 67.9 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 9, at page 211; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from April 7, 1908 for Willow Creek and May 29, 1907
for Black and Pole Creeks,
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre-feet
per acre during any irrigation season

The point of diversion is located in the

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

40.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
27.9 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 30
Township 15 South, Range 43 East, WM

Said right, together with the rights for the remaining portion of the land
under "Old Form" contracts, as described by said decree, is prior to the
rights of all other water users under the irrigation system of the Orchards
Water Company.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an
order of the State Engineer entered March 31, 1941 in Volume 4, page 31,
Special Order Records and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at
page 7317, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to
forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
