CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That ROGER L. ELI

of PO Box 64, Colton, State of Oregon 97017, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and five reservoirs, constructed under Permit R-7934

a tributary of Milk Creek for the purpose of fish culture

under Permit No. 44404 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 9, 1979 for 0.03 cubic foot per second, and September 6, 1979 for 0.09 cfs that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T5S, R3E, WM; Reservoir 1 - 650 feet North and 570 feet West, Reservoir 2 - 580 feet North and 505 feet West, Creek (Reservoirs 3, 4, and 5) - 450 feet North and 375 feet West, all from SE Corner NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 9
Township 5 South, Range 3 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
