CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

D.J. SAUNDERS AND G.B. SAUNDERS

of Richland, State of Oregon 97870, has
a right to the use of the waters of Eagle Creek

a tributary of Powder River for the purpose of
irrigation of 162.6 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1878 for 70 acres; 1903 for 42.6 acres; 1889 for 50 acres that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth cubic foot per second per acre.

The point of diversion is located in the Kay Young, Nash, and Newt Young Ditches

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

25.0 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4
15.0 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4
37.6 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4
35.0 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 15
10.0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
40.0 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 24
Township 9 South, Range 45 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 4723, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 28, 1980, approving transfer application No. 4530.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
