CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DAN L. FORSEA AND SONS, INC.

of Richland, State of Oregon 97870, has
a right to the use of the waters of Eagle Creek

a tributary of Powder River for the purpose of
irrigation of 10.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1885

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth
cubic foot per second per acre, if available at the original point of
diversion; NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 3, T9S, R45E, WM, Moody Ditch - 2130 feet
North and 650 feet East from SW Corner, Section 3.

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 33, T8S, R45E, WM, Newt
Young Ditch - 1950 feet South and 1400 feet East from NW Corner, Section 33.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

10.0 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 14
Township 9 South, Range 45 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved
by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 11, 1980 and together
with certificates of water right recorded at page 49433, Volume 43 and
page 52939, Volume 48, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes
certificate 4660.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to
forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
