## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

a tributary of Umpqua River wood products manufacturing including log storage

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 16477 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 23, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

 $1.56\ \rm cubic$  feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 2, T28S, R6W, WM; 3600 feet North and 2800 feet East from SW Corner, Section 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the
SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 33, T28S, R6W, WM;
900 feet North and 160 feet West from S 1/4 Corner, Section 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per area.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use, place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 13, 1977 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 17303, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
