CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That LARRY LEE HARRISON

of 500 Davidson Road, Williams, State of Oregon 97544, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Davidson Gulch

a tributary of Williams Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 3.87 acres

under Permit No. 2783 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 10, 1916

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 9, T39S, R5W, WM, 275 feet South and 1800 feet East from NW Corner Section 9

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 4, T39S, R5W, WM; 50 feet North and 940 feet West from S 1/4 Corner, Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.87 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 4
Township 39 South, Range 5 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 15, 1977 and to correctly describe the place of use and together with certificate of water right recorded at Page 52989, Volume 48, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes Certificate 31683.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
