## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

CARL B. JACOBSON

of 6265 West Side Road, Cave Junction, State of Oregon 97523, has a right to the use of the waters of Choke Cherry Gulch and springs

a tributary of West Fork Illinois River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.1 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1855

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 30, T39S, R8W, WM; Woodcock Ditch - 765 feet North and 950 feet West from SE Corner, Section 30.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.1 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Turner DLC 39  
Section 31  
Township 39 South, Range 8 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 6, 1972 and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 45765; Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 35807.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
