CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That EDWIN WEEKLY

of 815 Bender Street, Myrtle Point, State of Oregon 97458, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of three springs

a tributary of South Fork Coquille River for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area and stock under Permit No. 37029 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 16, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4), Section 8, T30S, R12W, WM, Diversion 1 - 20 feet South and 10 feet West; Diversion 2 - 30 feet South; Diversion 3 - 440 feet South and 150 feet West, all from Northeast Corner, Lot 4 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4) Section 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 4 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4)
Section 8
Township 30 South, Range 12 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
