CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That CITY OF PRINEY	ILLE
of Prineville State of Oregon	has a right to the use of
the waters of Ochoco Creek, a tributary of Crook	ed River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 400 acres of land, fire, sewerage and municipal

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State water mount of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1879,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for general municipal purposes, and five cubic feet per second for irrigation, the total cuantity being limited to four acre feet per acre during each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

40 acres in the SW 1_4 of SE 1_4 ; 40 acres in the SE 1_4 of SE 1_4 ; Section Thirty-one, (31): 40 acres in the SE 1_4 of SW 1_4 ; Section Thirty-two (32), Township Fourteen (14) South Range Sixteen (16) East of Willamette Meridian: 40 acres in the ME 1_4 of NE 1_4 ; 40 acres in the SE 1_4 of NE 1_4 ; Section Six (6): 40 acres in the NE 1_4 of NW 1_4 ; 40 acres in the SE 1_4 of NV 1_4 ; 40 acres in the SE 1_4 of NV 1_4 ; 5 Section Five (5) Township Fifteen (15) South Range Sixteen (16) East of Villamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
