CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JANE PENLAND

of Lexington, State of Oregon 97839, has a right to the use of the waters of Willow Creek

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 17.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 73; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the N 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 34.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16.0 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4
1.0 acre NW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 34
Township 1 South, Range 25 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 180, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on April 30, 1985, and also confirms a change in point of diversion approved by an order entered January 23, 1952.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
