under Permit No. 45277 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

May 6, 1980 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 13, T4N, R5W, WM; 930 feet South and 825 feet East from NW Corner, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _______ of one cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesuid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
